MHCWS High Point Awards – Open Show System (Non-licensed Competitions & OTAB/Opportunity/Academy Classes)

All general members of the Morgan Horse Club of Washington State are eligible to participate in this annual high point awards program. Horses owned or leased (proof of lease upon request) by club members earn points by placing in Open Shows, Schooling Shows, **non-licensed** Dressage & Western Dressage shows, as well as placing in an Opportunity or Academy Class at a traditional licensed show.

The calendar period for awards is November 1 through October 31. Placings from events must be sent to the High Point Secretary using the current official form. Submissions must be postmarked or emailed by October 1st. NOTE: Please notify Points Secretary if you intend to submit placings from any shows held from October 1st – October 31st. Points may not be awarded if applications contain incomplete or incorrect information.

AWARDS:

A prize to 1st place and ribbons to 1st place through 6th place in all divisions except Junior Exhibitor. A prize to 1st place and ribbons to 1st place through 8th place in the Junior Exhibitor Divisions.

POINTS:

Full points will be given to placings in all classes listed for each award division, regardless of class specifications or number of exhibitors. Double points will be given to all championships.

POINTS FORMULA:

1st place – 16 points / 2nd place – 14 points / 3rd place – 12 points / 4th place – 10 points / 5th place – 8 points / 6th place – 6 points / 7th place – 4 points / 8th place – 2 points
