## MHCWS High Point Awards – Rated Show System (Licensed Competitions)

All general members of the Morgan Horse Club of Washington State are eligible to participate in this annual high point awards program. A club member who is part of a syndicate or partnership or is a shareholder of a horse is also eligible to participate (proof of ownership upon request).

Horses owned or leased (proof of lease on request) by club members earn points by placing in Morgan and/or open classes at a competition licensed by USEF and/or appropriate official affiliated organization. Includes:

- USEF/USDF licensed Morgan breed shows (e.g., Key Classic, OMC, C-Fair, PNW, Morgan Grand National)
- USEF licensed Sport Horse competitions (e.g. Eventing, Combined Driving, Driven Dressage, Hunter-Jumper)
- USEF licensed/USDF recognized Dressage shows
- Licensed/Rated Competitive Trail competitions
- ADS (American Driving Society) licensed competition

Not included are all OTAB, Opportunity performance or Academy classes held at above events. These classes are included in the Open Show System and points should be reported there. Exception: dressage or western dressage classes at rated shows may be OTAB or Opportunity and scores count toward MHCWS rated system high point awards.

The calendar period for awards is November 1 through October 31. Placings from events must be sent to the High Point Secretary using the current official form. Submissions must be postmarked or emailed by October 1st, or the points will be forfeited. NOTE: Please notify Points Secretary if you intend to submit placings from any shows held from October 1<sup>st</sup> - October 31<sup>st</sup>. Points may not be awarded if applications are found to contain incomplete or incorrect information is submitted.

### AWARDS:

Perpetual plaque to 1<sup>st</sup> place and ribbons to 1<sup>st</sup> place through 6<sup>th</sup> place in all divisions except Junior Exhibitor or Youth. A perpetual plaque to 1<sup>st</sup> place and ribbons to 1<sup>st</sup> place through 8<sup>th</sup> place in the Junior Exhibitor and Youth divisions.

### POINTS:

Full points will be given to placings in all classes listed for each award division, regardless of class specifications or number of exhibitors. Double points given to all Championships; Performance, In-Hand and Equitation.

Points will be accrued from only the four best shows per horse or junior exhibitor. For junior exhibitor awards, only points for one horse/rider combination count per award category for the year. AMHA Medal classes will only count one time per exhibitor toward Jr. Exhibitor or Youth Award, with best placing used.

#### **POINTS FORMULA:**

1<sup>st</sup> place – 16 points / 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 14 points / 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 12 points / 4<sup>th</sup> place – 10 points / 5<sup>th</sup> place – 8 points / 6<sup>th</sup> place – 6 points / 7<sup>th</sup> place – 4 points / 8<sup>th</sup> place – 2 po

AMHA Medal Classes to count only one time per exhibitor per seat. Highest placing submitted will be used.

ALL OPPORTUNITY, OTAB or ACADEMY CLASSES COUNT TOWARD OPEN/UNRATED HIGH POINT AWARD PROGRAM ONLY. EXCEPTION – DRESSAGE OR WESTERN DRESSAGE MAY BE OTAB OR OPPORTUNITY AT RATED SHOWS.
