MHCWS High Point Awards – Competitive Trail Show System (Licensed Competitions)

All general members of the Morgan Horse Club of Washington State are eligible to participate in this annual high point awards program. A club member who is part of a syndicate or partnership or is a shareholder of a horse is also eligible to participate (proof of ownership upon request).

Horses owned or leased (proof of lease upon request) by club members earn points by placing in Morgan and/or open classes at a competition licensed or sanctioned by the appropriate governing body and/or appropriate USEF affiliated organization. This includes:

- NATRC Competitive Trail Rides Type B, 6-10 miles/ 1 day
- ACTHA and ETS Competitive Trail Challenge (CTC) All divisions (e.g., Novice, Intermediate or Advanced)
- ACTHA and ETS Obstacle Challenge (OC or AOC) All divisions (e.g., Novice, Intermediate or Advanced)
- IMTCA Mountain Trail and Challenge Trail
- OHC Mountain Trail

The calendar period for awards is November 1 through October 31. Placings from events must be sent to the High Point Secretary using the current official form. Submissions must be postmarked or emailed by October 1st, or the points will be forfeited. NOTE: Please notify the Points Secretary if you will be submitting points for any shows from October 1st - October 31st. Points may not be awarded if applications are found to contain incomplete or incorrect information.

AWARDS:

Perpetual plaque to 1st place and ribbons to 1st place through 6th place.

POINTS:

Full points will be given to placings in all classes, regardless of class specifications or number of exhibitors. Double points will be given to all Championships.

Points will be accrued from only the eight best shows per horse.

POINTS FORMULA:

 1^{st} place – 16 points / 2^{nd} place – 14 points / 3^{rd} place – 12 points / 4^{th} place – 10 points / 5^{th} place – 8 points / 6^{th} place – 6 points / 7^{th} place – 4 points / 8^{th} place – 2 points
